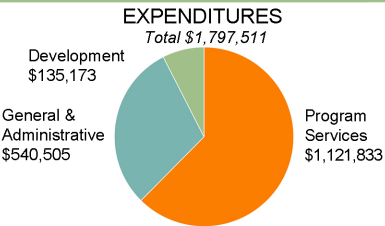
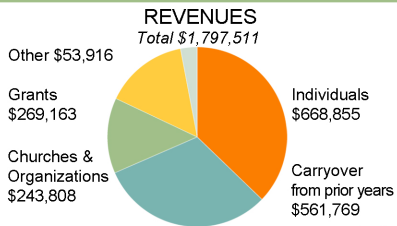
### SERVING FAMILIES IMPACTED BY COVID-19

EGC programs have worked tirelessly mobilizing, coordinating, and fundraising to help meet tangible needs of families most affected by COVID-19. We partnered with COPAHNI, Congregation Lion of Judah, Agência ALPHA and other partners to distribute diapers, food, clothing, and other resources that served over 600 families.



### RACE & CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY INITIATIVE

RCCI continues Christ's redemptive work by collaborating across racial lines to foster shalom in systems damaged by racism. This fall, we launched 2 cohorts, where White leaders can do the learning and self-work to engage issues related to race more effectively.
