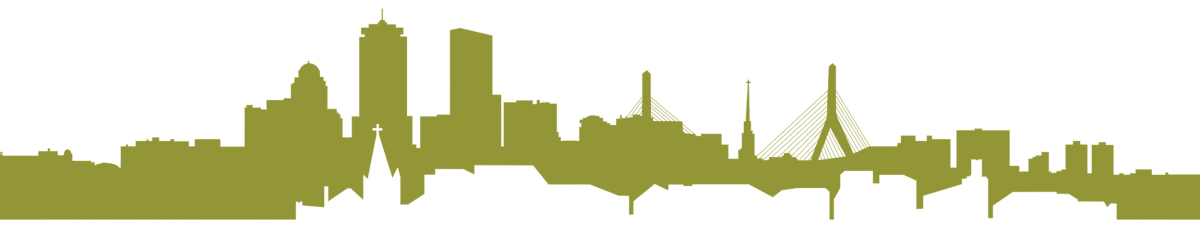

### SERVING FAMILIES IMPACTED BY COVID-19

At a time in the pandemic when families and schools were in great need, the Boston Education Collaborative and their partners stepped into the gap and recruited 120 volunteers to provide much-needed tutoring support to 14 schools. They met student needs through one-on-one tutoring, Zoom facilitation, coaching for parents, and in-person teacher aides.



### INTERCULTURAL MINISTRIES

IM provided leadership support, recruited volunteers, and helped raise over \$100,000 for three frontline, immigrant-led organizations to meet urgent community needs by hiring staff, purchasing food and supplies, and offering rent assistance to struggling families during the pandemic. We are also working with additional partners to welcome and support arriving Afghan refugees effectively.



### BOSTON BLACK CHURCH VITALITY PROJECT

This fall BBCVP launched its Thriving Cohort, a group of diverse Black churches committed to learning and collaboration. Participating churches are working together over the next three years to develop ministry practices more deeply rooted in the needs of Boston's Black community.
