CHURCH SYSTEMS HIGHLIGHT



INTERCULTURAL MINISTRIES

Intercultural Ministries trained leaders from over 50 churches in Christian-Muslim relations and developed a two-year program to recruit, train and mobilize volunteers to befriend and serve refugees resettling in Greater Boston.

URBAN ISSUES HIGHLIGHT



STARLIGHT MINISTRIES

Starlight Ministries trained over 450 individuals from over 50 churches, schools and organizations in Greater Boston to think systemically about homelessness and develop practical strategies for outreach. Starlight's network served over 750 individuals affected by homelessness through 6 outreach venues.

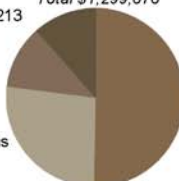

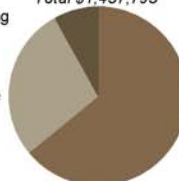
