GREATER BOSTON REFUGEE MINISTRY

GBRM trained over 200 Christian leaders from 50 congregations in refugee ministry. Leaders then formed local teams to build meaningful relationships with refugee families, providing holistic support in areas such as cultural and language learning, housing assistance, job readiness, spiritual support, and guidance toward realizing their hopes and dreams.

ABOLITIONIST NETWORK

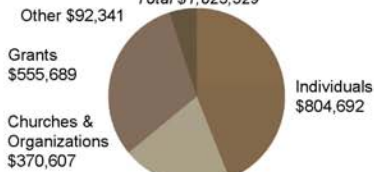

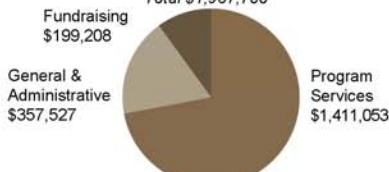
REVENUES
